There are forty Table-Top Spaces available with electrical and free wireless internet hookups. The Grand Opening Celebration will take place on Thursday October 19 at 5:30 PM inside the Exposition Hall. This area is open for the mixer, poster sessions and coffee breaks: Friday 9:00 AM - 6:00 PM and Saturday 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM. Security will be provided.

The fee for commercial vendors is \$800 and includes two registrations. The fee for academic institution representatives (non-vending) is \$400 and includes one registration. After the July 1 advanced registration deadline the fees will be \$900 and \$500 respectively. A list of exhibitors will be published in the program book and the company logo will be displayed in the meeting website.
